## This Week's Catechetical Theme: God the Holy Spirit – The Lord of Life

In the Third Article of the Apostles' Creed we confess "The holy Christian Church, the Communion of Saints." These are not two different things. We're not saying we believe in the holy Christian Church and the Communion of Saints. We're saying, in fact, that we believe in the holy Christian Church, which is the Communion of Saints. What this means is that the Church—the holy Christian Church—is made up of all true believers from all time and all places! It's a far larger group than those we see on Sunday morning. This is the topic of this week's devotional material. God bless your time in His Word!

**The Catechism:** 3<sup>rd</sup> Article of the Creed

What does this mean?

In the same way He calls, gathers, enlightens, and sanctifies the whole Christian church on earth, and keeps it with Jesus Christ in the one true faith. In this Christian church He daily and richly forgives all my sins and the sins of all believers. On the Last Day He will raise me and all the dead, and give eternal life to me and all believers in Christ. This is most certainly true.
