# The Catechism: The Epitome of the Formula of Concord - Article V

- 1. We believe, teach, and confess that the distinction between the Law and the Gospel is to be kept in the Church with great diligence as a particularly brilliant light. By this distinction, according to the admonition of St. Paul, God's Word is rightly divided (2 Tim. 2:15).
- 2. We believe, teach, and confess that the Law is properly a divine doctrine (Romans 7:12). It teaches what is right and pleasing to God, and it rebukes everything that is sin and contrary to God's will.
- 3. For this reason, then, everything that rebukes sin is, and belongs to, the preaching of the Law (FC Ep V 2-4).
