Sacraments in the OT

This Week's Catechetical Theme: Sacraments in the OT

The people of God who live after the time of Christ have been blessed to receive the Sacrament of Holy Baptism, and the Sacrament of the Altar. We have these two signs, which were instituted by Christ, which include visible elements, to which the LORD has attached His promise of forgiveness. But sacramental signs are nothing new. In fact, the people of God who lived in the Old Testament were blessed to receive numerous visible signs, to which the LORD had attached His promises, and by which they could be certain of the LORD's gracious favor. This week's catechesis considers five of them. God bless your time of devotion!

The Catechism: From Luther's Lectures on Genesis The Augsburg Confession – The Use of the Sacraments

Moreover, this passage also teaches us how God wants always to link His promise with a sign, just as previously, in the third chapter, we called attention to the garments of skins with which He clothed the naked human beings as a sign that He wanted to protect, defend, and preserve them. ... This sign should remind us to give thanks to God. For as often as the rainbow appears, it preaches to the entire world with a loud voice about the wrath which once moved God to destroy the whole world. It also gives comfort that we may have the conviction that God is kindly inclined toward us again and will never again make use of so horrible a punishment. Thus it teaches the fear of God and faith at the same time, the greatest virtues (AE 2, 144 & 148).
