CATECHETICAL THEME:

The Liturgy of Holy Baptism

This Week's Catechetical Theme: The Liturgy of Holy Baptism

The Baptism of Jesus sometimes confuses us as much as it confused John the Baptizer himself. Why is the sinless Son of God coming to be baptized when he has no apparent need of being baptized? This made no sense to John, and if we fail to look closely at the words of the text, it might make no sense to us. But Jesus isn't baptized in order to be forgiven. He is baptized, as the text says, "to fulfill all righteousness" (Matt. 3:15). That is to say, Jesus was baptized to satisfy the demands of the Law, and to begin His work of putting himself in the place of sinners in order to save those sinners. Jesus brings only His righteousness, and he walks away from His Baptism with our sin upon him. For us, it is just the other way around. We bring only our sin to Baptism, and we walk away with Jesus' righteousness as our own. This is the blessed exchange, and is what pleases the Father. Indeed, it is also what opens heaven to Jesus, and to us! Enjoy the readings this week as they further teach us concerning the liturgy of Holy Baptism. God bless your time in His Word!

Which aspect of making disciples does this passage encourage? **Fri:** In Holy Baptism, the Lord makes a promise to us. What do verses 6-7 serve to teach us? **Sat:** In preparation for Sunday, reflect upon today's texts.
