OT Types of the Lord's Supper: Manna in the Desert

This Week's Catechetical Theme: OT Types of the Lord's Supper: Manna in the Desert

This week, we continue our catechetical emphasis on The Sacrament of the Altar and will be examining Old Testament types that foreshadow the Lord's Supper. In the wilderness, having been rescued and redeemed from bondage in Egypt only one month before, the children of God begin to grumble against the LORD and wish to be back in Egypt. It's as if they have forgotten everything the LORD has done for them. They are ungrateful. They deserve to be punished, but the LORD cannot deny Himself or His Word. Though they deserve nothing but punishment, the LORD acts in mercy, and rains down bread from heaven. This heavenly bread would be the LORD's merciful provision by which they were sustained for 40 years in the wilderness. The LORD has given us bread from heaven as well, and this week, we'll examine how we also are to receive the LORD'S provision with thanksgiving, and according to His Word.

Questions to Discuss in the Home

Sun: Reflect upon today's text and sermon. **Mon:** Describe what the psalmist declares he will do for the children of Israel (v. 4)? How does this psalm depict and contrast the action of Israel verses the action of the LORD? **Tues:** Why was manna held in the holy place? What did this signify for the people of God? **Wed:** It had only been one month since the children of Israel had been rescued from bondage. How did the children of Israel speak toward God? Describe the foolishness of their speaking? What does the LORD promise to give to the children of Israel? Did the children of Israel receive it according to the LORD's Word? How was the giving of daily bread both a blessing and a test? **Thur:** What does Jesus call himself? How are we like the children of Israel, and unworthy recipients of heavenly bread? Where does Jesus gives us heavenly bread today? **Fri:** What had Jesus just said? How did the crowd respond? Why did they struggle to receive Jesus' words? What does Jesus promise in verse 54? **Sat:** In preparation for Sunday, reflect upon today's texts.
